AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto, " further providing for special education payments to school districts. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Sections 2509.1 and 2509.5 of the act of March 10 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, are amended by adding subsections to read: 11 12 Section 2509.1. Payments to Intermediate Units. -- * * 13 (b.15) Up to eleven million two hundred thousand dollars 14 (\$11,200,000) may be utilized for programs administered and 15 operated by intermediate units during the 2007-2008 school year for institutionalized children as established in subsection 16 17 (b.1).

- 2 Districts.--* * *
- 3 (vv) During the 2007-2008 school year, each school district
- 4 shall be paid the amount it received during the 2006-2007 school
- 5 year under subsections (rr), (ss), (tt) and (uu).
- 6 (ww) During the 2007-2008 school year, twenty-seven million
- 7 seven hundred and six thousand one hundred and ninety-seven
- 8 dollars (\$27,706,197) of the funds appropriated to the
- 9 <u>Department of Education for special education shall be used to</u>
- 10 provide supplemental funding for special education to all school
- 11 <u>districts</u>. Each school district shall receive a funding
- 12 <u>supplement calculated as follows:</u>
- 13 (1) multiply each school district's 2007-2008 market
- 14 value/income aid ratio by sixteen percent (16%) of its 2006-2007
- 15 <u>average daily membership;</u>
- 16 (2) multiply the product from paragraph (1) by twenty-seven
- 17 million dollars (\$27,000,000); and
- 18 (3) divide the resultant product from paragraph (2) by the
- 19 sum of the products of the 2007-2008 market value/income aid
- 20 ratio multiplied by sixteen percent (16%) of the 2006-2007
- 21 <u>average daily membership for all school districts.</u>
- 22 (xx) Each school district shall receive an inflation index
- 23 supplement as necessary so that the amounts under subsection
- 24 (ww) and this subsection equal three and four-tenths percent
- 25 (3.4%) multiplied by each school district's 2007-2008 market
- 26 <u>value/income aid ratio of the amount in subsection (vv).</u>
- 27 (yy) Each school district for which the sum of the
- 28 <u>supplements under subsections (ww) and (xx) provides an amount</u>
- 29 <u>less than two percent (2%) of the amount provided under</u>
- 30 subsection (vv) shall receive additional funding as necessary so

- 1 that the sum of the amounts provided under subsections (ww),
- 2 (xx) and this subsection equals two percent (2%) of the amount
- 3 provided under subsection (vv).
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
