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| 4 | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania |
| 5 | hereby enacts as follows: |
| 6 | Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated |
| 7 | Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: |
| 8 | <u>§ 1366. TreeVitalize plate.</u> |
| 9 | The department, in consultation with the Department of |
| 10 | Conservation and Natural Resources, shall design a special |
| 11 | TreeVitalize registration plate that utilizes the TreeVitalize |
| 12 | slogan in the design. Upon application of any person, |
| 13 | accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the |
| 14 | annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate |
| 15 | for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a gross |
| 16 | vehicle weight rating of not more than 9,000 pounds. The |
| 17 | TreeVitalize Fund shall receive \$15 of each additional fee for |
| 18 | this plate. |

1 Section 2. Section 1905 of Title 75 is amended by adding a
2 subsection to read:
3 § 1905. Payments to special funds.

5 (d) TreeVitalize Fund.--Fifteen dollars of each fee received
6 under section 1366 (relating to TreeVitalize plate) shall be
7 credited to the TreeVitalize Fund, established as follows:

8 (1) There is hereby established a special account in the 9 Treasury Department that shall be known as the TreeVitalize 10 Fund. The purpose of the TreeVitalize Fund is to address the 11 ongoing loss of trees in our Commonwealth.

12 (2) All moneys in the TreeVitalize Fund are hereby
 13 annually appropriated to the Department of Conservation and
 14 Natural Resources and may be expended for the purposes
 15 authorized under this subsection.

16 (3) Estimates of amounts to be expended under this
 17 subsection shall be submitted to the Governor by the
 18 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for his

19 <u>approval.</u>

20 (4) The State Treasurer shall not honor any requisition
 21 for expenditures by the Department of Conservation and

22 <u>Natural Resources in excess of estimates approved by the</u>

23 <u>Governor or in excess of the amount available for the</u>

24 purposes for which the requisition was made, whichever is the

25 <u>lesser amount.</u>

26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
