## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for display of United States flag and development of patriotism.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 771 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by
- 11 adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 771. Display of United States Flag; Development of
- 13 Patriotism.--\* \* \*
- 14 (e) (1) No teacher or administrator in a public school
- 15 entity shall be prohibited from using or reading from, during
- 16 the course of educational instruction, or from posting in a
- 17 public school building, classroom or event, any of the following

- 1 or any excerpts or portions of the following:
- 2 (i) The national motto.
- 3 (ii) The national anthem.
- 4 (iii) The Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5 (iv) The Constitution of the United States and the
- 6 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- 7 (v) The Declaration of Independence.
- 8 (vi) The writings, speeches, documents and proclamations of
- 9 the founders or Presidents of the United States or the founders
- 10 <u>or Governors of Pennsylvania.</u>
- 11 (vii) Opinions of the United States Supreme Court and
- 12 <u>Pennsylvania Supreme Court.</u>
- 13 (viii) Acts of the United States Congress and acts of the
- 14 Pennsylvania General Assembly.
- 15 (ix) Other historically significant or venerated documents,
- 16 <u>writings or records.</u>
- 17 (2) The use, reading or posting of the types of documents,
- 18 writings and records authorized by this section shall be
- 19 undertaken for educational purposes only and shall not be used,
- 20 read from or posted to promote or establish any religion or
- 21 <u>religious belief.</u>
- 22 (3) No person may impose content-based censorship of an
- 23 American or Pennsylvanian historical document, writing or record
- 24 based on any religious references contained in such document,
- 25 <u>writing or record.</u>
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
