AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," further providing for licensing fees.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 1006 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, amended December 21, 1988 (P.L.1883, No.185), is amended to read:

Section 1006. Fees.--Annual licenses shall be issued when the proper fee, if required, is received by the department and all the other conditions prescribed in this act are met. The department shall, by regulation, set fees for application for facility licensure and licensure renewal. For personal care homes, the fee shall be an application fee. [The fees shall be:

Facility
Adult day care center
Mental health establishment
Annual Fee
\$ 15

Personal care home-- 0 - 20 beds 15
-- 21 - 50 beds 20
-- 51 - 100 beds 30
--101 beds and above 50]

No fee shall be required for the annual license in the case of day care centers, family day care homes, boarding homes for children or for public or nonprofit mental institutions.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
