AN ACT

Amending the act of August 7, 1963 (P.L.549, No.290), entitled, 1 2 as amended, "An act creating the Pennsylvania Higher 3 Education Assistance Agency; defining its powers and duties; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Governor, 4 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of 5 Representatives, Superintendent of Public Instruction and the 6 Department of Auditor General; and making appropriations," 7 8 further providing for governing bodies.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 3(b) of the act of August 7, 1963

12 (P.L.549, No.290), referred to as the Pennsylvania Higher

13 Education Assistance Agency Act, is amended to read:

14 Section 3. Governing Bodies.--* * *

15 (b) (1) The board of directors shall provide for the

16 holding of regular and special meetings.

17 (2) Six directors attending shall constitute a quorum for
18 the transaction of any business and, unless a greater number is

required by <u>this section or</u> the by-laws of the agency, the act
 of a majority of the directors present at any meeting shall be
 deemed the act of the board.

(3) An affirmative vote of fifteen directors shall be 4 5 required to approve discretionary spending by the agency of any amount over twenty-five thousand dollars. Discretionary spending 6 means an expenditure that is not related to the agency's powers 7 8 and duties set forth in section 4. The term excludes an 9 employe's base salary or benefit package, but includes any bonus or compensation paid to an employe in addition to the base 10 salary or benefit package. 11 * * * 12

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
