AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State government; providing for the settlement, assessment, 3 collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts 4 5 due the Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and 6 other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, 7 or any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 8 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 9 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 10 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 13 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 14 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 15 16 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 17 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 18 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of 19 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 20 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 21 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every department, board, commission, and officer of the State 22 23 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 24 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 25 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 26 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 27 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 28 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 29 30 Commonwealth, " further providing for licensing of retailers.

- 2 Section 1. Section 206-A of the act of April 9, 1929
- 3 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended by
- 4 adding a paragraph to read:
- 5 Section 206-A. Licensing of Retailers.--Applicants for
- 6 retail license or renewal thereof shall meet the following
- 7 requirements:
- 8 * * *
- 9 (6) The applicant shall not offer clinical health care
- 10 services to the public. For the purposes of this paragraph,
- 11 <u>"clinical health care services" means operating a health clinic,</u>
- 12 providing health care, prescribing medications or any
- 13 <u>combination thereof</u>.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
