A RESOLUTION

1 Designating March 12, 2007, as "PACD Day" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, More than 50 years ago State legislators recognized  
3 the need to support grass-roots conservation efforts; and

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Association of Conservation  
5 Districts (PACD) provides conservation districts with education  
6 and information to assist them with land and water conservation;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, PACD is a nonprofit organization that supports,  
9 enhances and promotes Pennsylvania's conservation districts and  
10 their programs; and

11 WHEREAS, PACD volunteers study county natural resource issues  
12 and make decisions which enhance and protect their community;  
13 and

1       WHEREAS, Conservation districts serve a range of agricultural  
2 and urban interests; and

3       WHEREAS, In the 1970s and 1980s local governments delegated  
4 important responsibilities to conservation districts to assist  
5 with portions of The Clean Streams Law and the Nutrient  
6 Management Act; and

7       WHEREAS, PACD primarily serves as the collective voice for  
8 Pennsylvania's 66 county conservation districts; therefore be it

9       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, in recognition  
10 of the important work of the PACD, designate March 12, 2007, as  
11 "PACD Day" in Pennsylvania.
