- 1 Honoring the life and service of Philadelphia Police Officer 2 Charles "Chuck" Cassidy, who was fatally wounded in the line 3 of duty on October 31, 2007, and lost his life the following
- day, and extending deep appreciation and sympathy to the wife
- 5 and children of Officer Cassidy.
- 6 WHEREAS, Charles Cassidy served the people of Philadelphia
- 7 for 25 years as an officer with the Philadelphia Police

- 1 Department; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy's service was marked by unwavering
- 3 commitment to the citizens of Philadelphia and to the highest of
- 4 professional standards and conduct as a colleague to his sisters
- 5 and brothers in blue; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy embraced and fully embodied the role
- 7 and responsibilities of a public servant by his energetic
- 8 example, through the mentoring of fellow officers and by the
- 9 relationships he cultivated with students, workers and retirees
- 10 in the neighborhoods he patrolled; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy further honored his profession and
- 12 uniform by living a life of service as a husband, father,
- 13 friend, neighbor, youth advocate, soccer coach and devoted
- 14 parishioner of St. Jerome Roman Catholic Church; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Officer Cassidy's years of service in the
- 16 Philadelphia Police Department were epitomized by being present
- 17 when people needed him, including the interruption of an armed
- 18 robbery on October 31, 2007; and
- 19 WHEREAS, On that date, Officer Cassidy was fatally wounded in
- 20 the line of duty and lost his life the following day, November
- 21 1, 2007; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 23 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania honor the heroic life lived and
- 24 extend heartfelt condolences for the supreme sacrifice made by
- 25 Officer Charles "Chuck" Cassidy; and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That, on behalf of a grateful citizenry, a copy of
- 27 this resolution be transmitted to Officer Charles Cassidy's
- 28 wife, Judy; to his children, Katie, Colby and John; and to his
- 29 comrades in the 35th Police District, Philadelphia.
