- 9 has become a tireless advocate for others who have disabilities

- 11 WHEREAS, Ms. Owens, her family and Mr. Jeff Hladio, a
- 12 lifelong friend, have worked to assist other young people who
- 13 are disabled in making a smooth transition between an
