WHEREAS, At an awards ceremony in Washington, DC, on October 4 5 21, 2008, the Federal Department of Education recognized 230 schools in the nation as 2008 No Child Left Behind - Blue Ribbon б Schools; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of these schools, an achievement signifying the high level of academic success its 9

12 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of only 12 schools 13 and three high schools to make a presentation during the awards 14 ceremony, presenting the "Scheduling for Success" program it 15 initiated during the 2001-2002 school year and has used since 16 then with increasing success; and WHEREAS, "Scheduling for Success" recognized the value of
good nutrition, and a free breakfast program was made available
to all students; and

4 WHEREAS, In addition, the homeroom system was redesigned to 5 create remedial mathematics and remedial reading opportunities, 6 with students assigned to homerooms based upon their 7 Pennsylvania System of School Assessment test scores; and 8 WHEREAS, Homer-Center High School was one of only 12 schools 9 in this Commonwealth to be honored this year as a Blue Ribbon 10 school; therefore be it
