## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death 3 benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law 4 5 enforcement officers or National Guard members killed in the performance of their duties, " further providing for eligibility for benefits for members of certain ambulance 7 services or rescue squads. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency and Law Enforcement 12 Personnel Death Benefits Act, is amended by adding a subsection 13 14 to read: 15 Section 1. 16 (c.1) (1) An ambulance service or rescue squad member 17 working for a hospital shall be deemed to be acting in the 18 performance of his duties for the purposes of this act 19 attending, going to or directly returning from an emergency

- 1 which the ambulance service or rescue squad attended,
- including travel from and direct return to the hospital or 2
- 3 other place where the ambulance service or rescue squad is
- 4 stationed.
- (2) This subsection shall only apply to a hospital 5
- 6 employee who is directed to respond to an emergency pursuant
- 7 to an agreement to provide emergency service coverage for a
- political subdivision. 8

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 10
