13	Section 1. Section 4(c) of the act of June 21, 1939
14	(P.L.626, No.294), referred to as the Second Class County
15	Assessment Law, is amended to read:
16	Section 4. The Board of Property Assessment, Appeals and
17	Review shall have power and its duty shall be:

19	(c) To hear all cases of appeals from assessments, and all
20	complaints as to assessments, errors, exonerations and
21	refunds[.], provided that, and notwithstanding any other

1	provision of law to the contrary, the board is prohibited from
2	imposing or assessing any type of fee relating to any case heard
3	by it pursuant to the authority conferred under this subsection.

5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
