AN ACT

Amending the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), entitled "An act relating to health care; prescribing the powers and duties of the Department of Health; establishing and providing the powers and duties of the State Health Coordinating Council, health systems agencies and Health Care Policy Board in the Department of Health, and State Health Facility Hearing Board in the Department of Justice; providing for certification of need of health care providers and prescribing penalties," providing for quality assurance inspections.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known
as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a
section to read:
Section 813.1. Quality assurance inspections.
Notwithstanding any other inspection performed by the
department under this chapter, the department shall on an annual
basis conduct random, unannounced inspections of 25% of the
licensed health care facilities within this Commonwealth. The
purpose of the inspection shall be to ensure that health care

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
