AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties," further providing for unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $5(a)$ of the act of July 22,1974 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act, is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined.--(a) "Unfair methods of competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the business of insurance means:

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(15) A homeowners or personal lines residential property insurer disclosing or submitting to any claims history report provider, or to any other consumer reporting agency, any 2 in which a payment was not made unless this information is

information regarding any inquiry or claim made by the insured payout claim.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
