8	Section 1. Sections 3742(a) and 3743(a) of Title 75 of the
9	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.
11	(a) General rule[The] <u>Except as otherwise provided in</u>
12	section 3743.2 (relating to leaving scene of accident), the
13	driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
14	injury or death of any person shall immediately stop the vehicle
15	at the scene of the accident or as close thereto as possible but
16	shall then forthwith return to and in every event shall remain
17	at the scene of the accident until he has fulfilled the
18	requirements of section 3744 (relating to duty to give
19	information and render aid). Every stop shall be made without

1 obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

3 § 3743. Accidents involving damage to attended vehicle or4 property.

5 General rule.--[The] Except as otherwise provided in (a) section 3743.2 (relating to leaving scene of accident), the 6 driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting only in 7 damage to a vehicle or other property which is driven or 8 attended by any person shall immediately stop the vehicle at the 9 10 scene of the accident or as close thereto as possible but shall 11 forthwith return to and in every event shall remain at the scene 12 of the accident until he has fulfilled the requirements of 13 section 3744 (relating to duty to give information and render 14 aid). Every stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more 15 than is necessary.

Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read: <u>§ 3743.2. Leaving scene of accident.</u>

19 (a) General rule.--The driver of a vehicle involved in an 20 accident subject to the provisions of section 3742 (relating to 21 accidents involving death or personal injury) or 3743 (relating 22 to accidents involving damage to attended vehicle or property) 23 who is in reasonable fear of his safety or the safety of his 24

(1) May leave the scene of the accident.

26 (2) Shall report the accident by telephone or in person
27 to the nearest police department as soon as safely possible
28 after the accident.

29 (3) Shall submit to the police department the

- 2 (b) Penalty.--Any person violating this section commits a
- 3 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 4 <u>a fine of \$300 or to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or</u>
- 5 <u>both.</u>
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
