## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for appointments by the
- 3 appointing authority.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1201(k) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 1, 2006 (P.L.1243,
- 8 No.135), is amended to read:
- 9 § 1201. Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board established.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (k) Appointments.--The appointing authorities shall make
- 12 their [initial] appointments within 60 days of [the effective
- 13 date of this part.] a vacancy in an office for which such
- 14 appointing authority is responsible for making an appointment.
- 15 No appointment shall be final until receipt by the appointing
- 16 authority of the required background investigation of the
- 17 appointee by the Pennsylvania State Police which shall be

- 1 completed within 30 days[.], and until the advice and consent of
- 2 a majority of the members elected to the Senate has been given.
- 3 No person who has been convicted in any domestic or foreign
- 4 jurisdiction of a felony, infamous crime or gaming offense shall
- 5 be appointed to the board.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
