AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for reporting of secondary school athletics equity.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949 , is amended by adding a article to read:

## ARTICLE XVI-C

REPORTING OF SECONDARY SCHOOL ATHLETICS EQUITY

Section 1601-C. Scope of article.
This article requires reporting by school entities on
athletic opportunities afforded to male and female secondary
school students.
Section 1602-C. Definitions.
The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
reported school year.
(iii) The seasons during which each interscholastic athletic team competed.
(iv) The total expenditures for each interscholastic athletic team in the reported school year, which shall include the following data:
(A) The total amount of expenditures for
transportation.
(B) The total amount of expenditures for entry
fees to participate in athletic competitions, if any.
(C) The total amount of expenditures for
athletic equipment, including expenditures for the purchase and any schedule for the replacement of athletic equipment and team uniforms.
(D) Both capital budget and maintenance expenditures for sports facilities, including improvements to or expansion of sports facilities, rentals of sports facilities, maintenance and repair of sports facilities. For the purposes of this subparagraph, sports facilities shall include locker rooms, fields and gymnasiums.
(v) The total number of trainers by employment status (full-time, part-time, head and assistant).
(vi) The total number of coaches by status (fulltime, part-time, head and assistant).
(vii) The total number of competitions scheduled.
(c) Copies.--The department shall make copies of all submitted reports available for public inspection on the department's publicly accessible Internet website.
(d) Annual report.--The department shall prepare and submit

an annual report to the General Assembly regarding the
compliance with the reporting requirements of this article and
the expenditures and participation rates regarding
interscholastic athletic opportunities for each gender, and
other such information as the department deems relevant.
Section 1605-C. Regulations.
    The department may promulgate any rules, regulations or
standards to administer this article.
    Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
