9	Section 1. The definition of "eligible provider" in section
10	1511-D of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as
11	the Public School Code of 1949, added July 20, 2007 (P.L.278,
12	No.45), is amended to read:
13	Section 1511-D. Definitions.
14	The following words and phrases when used in this subarticle
15	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16	context clearly indicates otherwise:

18	"Eligible provider." Any of the following entities if the
19	entity complies with all quality program standards established

1	by the Department of Education:
2	(1) A school district.
3	(2) A Head Start program.
4	(3) A nursery school licensed under the act of January
5	28, 1988 (P.L.24, No.11), known as the Private Academic
6	Schools Act.
7	(4) [A] <u>One of the following:</u>
8	(i) Prior to July 1, 2009, a child day care center
9	[or], a group day care home <u>or a registered family day</u>
10	care home that has met or exceeded the standards of STAR
11	2 under the Keystone STARS quality rating system
12	established by the Department of Public Welfare.
13	<u>(ii) After June 30, 2009, a child day care center,</u>
14	group day care home or a registered family day care home
15	that has met or exceeded the standards of STAR 3 under
16	the Keystone STARS quality rating system established by
17	the Department of Public Welfare.

19	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, or
20	immediately, whichever is later.
