- 5 children in tow to celebrate the 15th annual Take Our Daughters
- 6 To Work and Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day; and
- 7 WHEREAS, "Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day" is part of
- 8 the Ms. Foundation for Women's campaign to help children achieve
- 9 their full potential in the home, school and community and
- 10 explore future opportunities in the workplace; and
- 11 WHEREAS, "Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day" inspires
- 12 all children, regardless of economic, social and physical
- 13 challenges, to succeed in all future aspects of their adult
- 14 life; and
- 15 WHEREAS, "Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day"
- 16 meaningfully addresses the roles of men and women as part of the
