- 5 finance for Mesirow Financial and a member of Seton Hill
- 6 University board of trustees; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mr. White was beloved by fans and fellow players for
- 8 his on-field dominance and off-field warmth and humor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. White generously contributed his energies to
- 10 Pittsburgh area charities and chaired the Governor's Council on
- 11 Physical Fitness; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Drafted by the Pittsburgh Steelers in 1971, Mr.
- 13 White was a member of the Steel Curtain defensive line which led
- 14 the team to four Super Bowl titles; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. White, known as "Mad Dog," famously left the
- 16 hospital where he was being treated for pneumonia to join his
- 17 team in their 1975 Super Bowl championship victory against the

- 1 Minnesota Vikings; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. White was a two-time Pro Bowl player and was
- 3 named to the Steelers 75th Season All-Time Team; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 1980 Mr. White retired from the NFL and embarked
- 5 on his distinguished career in the financial industry in
- 6 Pittsburgh; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Senate extends deepest condolences to Mr.
- 8 White's wife, Karen and daughter, Stacey; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate note with sadness the passing of
- 10 former Pittsburgh Steelers defensive end Dwight White; and be it
