## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," further providing for the imposition of 10 inheritance tax. 11
- 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. Section 2106 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
- 15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, added August 4,
- 16 1991 (P.L.97, No.22), is amended to read:
- 17 Section 2106. Imposition of Tax. -- An inheritance tax for the
- 18 use of the Commonwealth is imposed upon every transfer that
- 19 exceeds two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) and is

- 1 subject to tax under this article at the rates specified in
- 2 section 2116.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
