AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 - Statutes, further providing for restoration of operating
- 3 privilege.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1545 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1545. Restoration of operating privilege.
- 9 Upon the restoration of any person's operating privilege
- 10 which has been suspended or revoked pursuant to this subchapter
- 11 or pursuant to Chapter 38 (relating to driving after imbibing
- 12 alcohol or utilizing drugs), such person's record shall show
- 13 five points, except that any additional points assessed against
- 14 the person since the date of the last violation resulting in the
- 15 suspension or revocation shall be added to such five points
- 16 unless the person has served an additional period of suspension
- 17 or revocation pursuant to section 1544(a) (relating to

- 1 additional period of revocation or suspension). This section
- 2 shall not apply to section 1532(d) (relating to suspension of
- 3 operating privilege), 1533 (relating to suspension of operating
- 4 privilege for failure to respond to citation) or to 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 5 6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges).
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
