## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 2, 1947 (P.L.143, No.62), entitled "An 1 act regulating the sale and resale for profit and the 2 carrying on of the business of selling or reselling tickets or other devices for admission to places of amusement; providing for the licensing of persons reselling such tickets 5 for profit; providing for the suspension and revocation of 6 such licenses; imposing duties on licensees and owners or 7 operators of places of amusement; imposing powers and duties 9 on the Department of Revenue, county treasurers, district attorneys, and the receiver of taxes, and city solicitors in 10 cities of the first class; making disposition of moneys 11 collected and providing penalties," providing for ticket 12 purchasing software and for penalties. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of May 2, 1947 (P.L.143, No.62), entitled 16 17 "An act regulating the sale and resale for profit and the carrying on of the business of selling or reselling tickets or 18 19 other devices for admission to places of amusement; providing 20 for the licensing of persons reselling such tickets for profit; 21 providing for the suspension and revocation of such licenses; 22 imposing duties on licensees and owners or operators of places

- 5 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 6 <u>Section 12.1. Ticket Purchasing Software; Violation.--(a)</u>
- 7 It is unlawful for any person knowingly to sell, give, possess,
- 8 <u>use or otherwise distribute or possess with the intent to sell,</u>
- 9 give or distribute software that is primarily designed or
- 10 produced for the purpose of interfering with the operations of
- 11 any ticket seller that sells, over the Internet, tickets of
- 12 <u>admission to a sporting event, theater, musical performance or</u>
- 13 place of public entertainment or amusement of any kind by
- 14 circumventing any security measures on the ticket seller's
- 15 website, circumventing any access control systems of the ticket
- 16 seller's website or circumventing any controls or measures that
- 17 are instituted by the ticket seller on its website to ensure an
- 18 equitable ticket buying process.
- (b) For purposes of this section, "ticket seller" means any
- 20 person that has executed a written agreement with the management
- 21 of any venue for a sporting event, theater, musical performance
- 22 or public entertainment or amusement of any kind to sell tickets
- 23 to the event over the Internet.
- 24 (c) Any person who violates this section commits a
- 25 misdemeanor of the third degree. Every acquisition, sale or
- 26 offer for sale constitutes a separate violation.
- 27 <u>(d) The court, in imposing a sentence, shall order</u>
- 28 restitution pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. § 1106 (relating to
- 29 restitution for injuries to person or property).
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
