AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for payment of fees associated with certification by the National Board for 6 Professional Teaching Standards. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an 12 article to read: 13 ARTICLE XI-B 14 CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR 15 PROFESSIONAL TEACHING STANDARDS Section 1101-B. Definitions. 16 17 The following words and phrases when used in this article

shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

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- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 3 Commonwealth.
- 4 <u>"Eligible teacher." A teacher who has:</u>
- 5 (1) Completed three full years of teaching in a
- 6 Pennsylvania public school, intermediate unit or area
- 7 vocational-technical school.
- 8 <u>(2) A current, full-time teaching position in a</u>
- 9 <u>Pennsylvania public school, intermediate unit or area</u>
- 10 vocational-technical school.
- 11 (3) Not previously received Commonwealth funds for
- 12 participating in any certification area of the NBPTS program.
- 13 (4) Not repaid any Commonwealth funds previously
- 14 <u>received for the NBPTS certification process.</u>
- 15 (5) Not received a waiver of repayment from the
- 16 <u>Department of Education.</u>
- 17 "National Board for Professional Teaching Standards" or
- 18 "NBPTS." The independent, nonprofit organization established in
- 19 1987 to establish high standards for teachers' knowledge and
- 20 performance and for development and operation of a national
- 21 voluntary system to assess and certify teachers who meet those
- 22 standards.
- 23 "Public school." A school operated by a school district,
- 24 charter school, cyber charter school or an area vocational-
- 25 technical school.
- 26 Section 1102-B. Program.
- 27 <u>(a) Establishment.--A program to help defray the cost to</u>
- 28 teachers of becoming certified by the National Board for
- 29 <u>Professional Teaching Standards is established.</u>
- 30 (b) Goal.--It is the goal of the Commonwealth to provide

- 1 opportunities and incentives for excellent teachers and to
- 2 retain them in the teaching profession. To attain this goal, the
- 3 <u>Commonwealth shall support the efforts of teachers to achieve</u>
- 4 <u>national certification by providing reimbursement for approved</u>
- 5 paid leave time for teachers participating in the certification
- 6 process and paying the assessment fee for teachers who seek to
- 7 attain national certification from the National Board for
- 8 <u>Professional Teaching Standards.</u>
- 9 <u>Section 1103-B. Payment of fees.</u>
- 10 Eligible teachers who participate in NBPTS certification
- 11 shall be entitled to do so without loss of pay or time. To the
- 12 <u>extent funds are available, the Commonwealth shall do all of the</u>
- 13 following:
- 14 (1) Pay all or a portion of the cost of NBPTS assessment
- fees on behalf of an eligible teacher to become NBPTS
- 16 certified or recertified.
- 17 (2) Reimburse school districts for substitute fees for
- 18 each day the eligible teacher participates in preparation for
- 19 NBPTS certification, up to three days.
- 20 Section 1104-B. Priority.
- 21 (a) Schools in school improvement or corrective action. --
- 22 Eliqible teachers who teach in schools identified as in school
- 23 improvement or corrective action shall receive first priority
- 24 for payment of assessment fees under this article. The eliqible
- 25 teachers' districts shall also receive first priority for
- 26 <u>substitute fees reimbursement.</u>
- 27 (b) Other priority. -- Eligible teachers who teach early
- 28 childhood education, mathematics or science at the middle or
- 29 secondary level or who teach special education or foreign
- 30 languages shall receive second priority for payment of

- 1 assessment fees under this article. The eligible teachers'
- 2 districts shall also receive second priority for substitute fees
- 3 reimbursement.
- 4 <u>Section 1105-B. Duties of eligible teachers.</u>
- 5 (a) Completion of process. -- An eliqible teacher on whose
- 6 <u>behalf the assessment fee is paid shall agree to complete the</u>
- 7 <u>certification process or be subject to repayment as set forth in</u>
- 8 section 1106-B(a).
- 9 (b) Three-year commitment. -- An eliquible teacher on whose
- 10 behalf the assessment fee is paid and who receives NBPTS
- 11 certification shall, in addition to the requirement under
- 12 <u>subsection (a), agree to serve as a teacher or administrator in</u>
- 13 <u>a Pennsylvania public school for a period of at least three</u>
- 14 years or be subject to repayment as set forth in section 1106-
- 15 B(b). Eligible teachers who receive priority under section 1104-
- 16 B and who receive NBPTS certification shall teach in that
- 17 priority class for the three-year commitment period. If an
- 18 eliqible teacher receives priority under section 1104-B(a) and
- 19 the school is removed from improvement or corrective action
- 20 during the three-year commitment period, service in the same
- 21 school or in another school identified as in school improvement
- 22 or corrective action shall continue to fulfill the requirements
- 23 of this subsection.
- 24 Section 1106-B. Repayment.
- 25 (a) Failure to complete the certification process.--When an
- 26 eligible teacher for whom the Commonwealth has paid the
- 27 assessment fee fails to complete the certification process, the
- 28 teacher shall reimburse the Commonwealth for the amount of the
- 29 assessment fee. A candidate who completes the certification
- 30 process but is denied NBPTS certification shall not be subject

- 1 to repayment pursuant to this subsection.
- 2 (b) Failure to continue teaching. -- When an eligible teacher
- 3 for whom the Commonwealth has paid the assessment fee fails to
- 4 <u>teach in a Pennsylvania public school for three consecutive</u>
- 5 years after completing the certification process, the teacher
- 6 shall reimburse the Commonwealth for the amount of the
- 7 <u>assessment fee. The teacher shall certify to the department each</u>
- 8 year that the teacher is in compliance with section 1105-B(b).
- 9 (c) Waiver of repayment. -- Upon the application of the
- 10 eligible teacher, the department shall waive the repayment
- 11 requirement if the department finds that the teacher was unable
- 12 to complete the process or continue teaching in a priority class
- 13 or school identified as in school improvement or corrective
- 14 action due to administrative action on the part of the school
- 15 district or area vocational-technical school for other than
- 16 <u>causes enumerated in section 1122</u>, or continue teaching due to
- 17 illness of the teacher, the death or catastrophic illness of a
- 18 member of the teacher's immediate family, or parental leave to
- 19 care for a newborn or newly adopted child and may waive the
- 20 repayment requirement due to other extraordinary circumstances.
- 21 Section 1107-B. Duties of department.
- 22 (a) Guidelines. -- The department shall develop quidelines
- 23 necessary for the implementation of this article.
- 24 (b) Technical assistance. -- To the extent funds are
- 25 <u>available</u>, the department shall provide technical assistance to
- 26 NBPTS applicants. The department may contract with one or more
- 27 <u>institutions of higher education or intermediate units in order</u>
- 28 to provide technical assistance.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
