1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in intermediate units, providing for school social work services; and, in professional employees, further providing for definitions; AND PROVIDING FOR SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKERS.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
12	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
13	section to read:
14	Section 923.3 A. School Social Work Services. (a)
15	Intermediate units or school districts may offer a program of
16	school social work services as part of the offering of pupil
17	personnel services.
18	(b) Definitions. As used in this section:
19	"School social worker" shall mean a certified employe who

- 1 provides social work services and support to students and their
- 2 families and who holds a license in good standing as a licensed
- 3 social worker or a licensed clinical social worker under the act
- 4 of July 9, 1987 (P.L.220, No.39), known as the "Social Workers,
- 5 Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act."
- 6 <u>"School social work services" shall mean social work services</u>
- 7 provided in the setting of an educational agency by a school
- 8 social worker. The term includes:
- 9 (1) Prevention and intervention services. This paragraph
- 10 includes strengthening school systems and fostering healthy
- 11 <u>climates.</u>
- 12 <u>(2) Assessments. This paragraph includes special education</u>
- 13 <u>evaluations</u>, <u>functional behavior</u>, <u>manifestation determinations</u>,
- 14 <u>behavior interventions and mental health recommendations.</u>
- 15 <u>(3) Counseling services. This paragraph includes individual</u>
- 16 <u>counseling</u>, <u>group counseling</u>, <u>family counseling and alcohol and</u>
- 17 drug counseling.
- 18 (4) Consultation. This paragraph includes classroom
- 19 <u>observations</u>, teacher consultations, case conferences and
- 20 <u>consultation with administration on program needs.</u>
- 21 (5) Parent and community liaison. This paragraph includes
- 22 home school community liaison, engaging community in student
- 23 success and home visits.
- 24 (6) Violence reduction. This paragraph includes child abuse
- 25 recognition and reporting, crisis intervention, peer mediation,
- 26 anger management and bully proofing.
- 27 (7) Referrals and collaboration. This paragraph includes
- 28 linking students to community resources and collaborating with
- 29 <u>outside agencies.</u>
- 30 (8) Assuring compliance with Federal mandates.

- 1 (9) School involvement. This paragraph includes classroom
- 2 presentations, school wide assembly presentations and
- 3 participation in school committees.
- 4 (10) Training. This paragraph includes social skills,
- 5 parenting skills, staff in-service and parent-teacher
- 6 <u>organization training.</u>
- 7 Section 2. Section 1101 of the act, amended November 30,
- 8 1971 (P.L.546, No.144), is amended to read:
- 9 SECTION 1. SECTION 1101(1) OF THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949,
- 11 AMENDED NOVEMBER 30, 1971 (P.L.546, NO.144), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 12 Section 1101. Definitions. -- As used in this article,
- 13 (1) The term "professional employe" shall include those who
- 14 are certificated as teachers, supervisors, supervising
- 15 principals, principals, assistant principals, vice-principals,
- 16 directors of vocational education, dental hygienists, visiting
- 17 teachers, home and school visitors, school social workers,
- 18 school counselors, child nutrition program specialists, school
- 19 librarians, school secretaries the selection of whom is on the
- 20 basis of merit as determined by eligibility lists and school
- 21 nurses.
- 22 (2) The term "substitute" shall mean any individual who has
- 23 been employed to perform the duties of a regular professional
- 24 employe during such period of time as the regular professional
- 25 employe is absent on sabbatical leave or for other legal cause
- 26 authorized and approved by the board of school directors or to-
- 27 perform the duties of a temporary professional employe who is
- 28 absent.
- 29 (3) The term "temporary professional employe" shall mean any
- 30 individual who has been employed to perform, for a limited time,

- 1 the duties of a newly created position or of a regular
- 2 professional employe whose services have been terminated by
- 3 death, resignation, suspension or removal.
- 4 (4) The term "school social worker" shall have the meaning
- 5 given in section 923.3-A(b).

- 7 SECTION 2. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
- 8 SECTION 1107.1. SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKERS.--(A) AN INDIVIDUAL
- 9 EMPLOYED BY A SCHOOL ENTITY AS A SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER MUST HOLD
- 10 A SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 11 EDUCATION.
- 12 (B) THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) SHALL NOT APPLY TO AN
- 13 INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 14 (1) MEETS THE EXCEPTION FOR SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKERS STATED IN
- 15 SECTION 3 OF THE ACT OF JULY 9, 1987 (P.L.220, NO.39), KNOWN AS
- 16 THE "SOCIAL WORKERS, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS AND
- 17 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS ACT"; OR
- 18 (2) IS EMPLOYED AS A SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER BY A SCHOOL ENTITY
- 19 OR PRIVATE SCHOOL IN THIS COMMONWEALTH PRIOR TO THE DEVELOPMENT
- 20 OF A SOCIAL WORKER CERTIFICATE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.
- 21 (C) A SOCIAL WORKER PERFORMING SERVICES IN A SCHOOL ENTITY
- 22 MAY WORK UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A SUPERINTENDENT, ASSISTANT
- 23 <u>SUPERINTENDENT OR OTHER SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR OR EMPLOYE AS</u>
- 24 DETERMINED BY THE SCHOOL ENTITY.
- 25 (D) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A SCHOOL
- 26 SOCIAL WORKER CERTIFICATE NO LATER THAN SIXTY (60) DAYS AFTER
- 27 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
- 28 (E) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "SCHOOL
- 29 ENTITY" SHALL MEAN ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE
- 30 UNIT, CHARTER SCHOOL OR AREA VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
