## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for driving on right side of
- roadway, for overtaking vehicle on the left, for no-passing
- zones, for driving on roadways laned for traffic, for
- 5 required position and method of turning and for minimum speed
- 6 regulation.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 3301 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 10 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 11 § 3301. Driving on right side of roadway.
- 12 (a) General rule. -- Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a
- 13 vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway
- 14 except as follows:
- 15 (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle
- 16 proceeding in the same direction where permitted by the rules
- 17 governing such movement.

- 1 (2) When [an obstruction] <u>a condition</u> exists making it
  2 necessary to drive to the left of the center of the roadway,
  3 provided the driver yields the right-of-way to all vehicles
  4 traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed
  5 portion of the roadway within such distance as to constitute
  6 a hazard.
  - (3) When and where official traffic-control devices are in place designating a lane or lanes to the left side of the center of the roadway for the movement indicated by the devices.
    - (4) Upon a roadway restricted to one-way traffic.
  - (5) When making a left turn as provided in sections 3322 (relating to vehicle turning left) and 3331 (relating to required position and method of turning).
- 15 <u>(6) In accordance with section 3303(a)(3) (relating to overtaking vehicle on the left).</u>
  - (b) Vehicle proceeding at less than normal speed .--
    - (1) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into an alley, private road or driveway.
      - (2) This subsection does not apply to [a]:
- 27 (i) A driver who must necessarily drive in a lane
  28 other than the right-hand lane to continue on his
  29 intended route.
- 30 <u>(ii) Pedalcycles operating in accordance with</u>

- 3 (iii) Pedalcycles using any portion of the available
- 4 <u>roadway due to unsafe surface conditions.</u>
- 5 <u>(iv) Pedalcycles on a roadway having width for not</u>
- 6 more than one lane of traffic in each direction.
- 7 Section 2. Section 3303(a) of Title 75 is amended by adding
- 8 a paragraph to read:
- 9 § 3303. Overtaking vehicle on the left.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The following rules shall govern the
- 11 overtaking and passing of vehicles proceeding in the same
- 12 direction, subject to the limitations, exceptions and special
- 13 rules stated in this chapter:
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (3) The driver of a motor vehicle overtaking a
- 16 <u>pedalcycle proceeding in the same direction shall pass to the</u>
- 17 left of the pedalcycle in a lane adjacent to that of the
- 18 pedalcycle if possible in accordance with section 3305
- 19 <u>(relating to limitations on overtaking on the left) or within</u>
- 20 <u>not less than four feet at a careful and prudent reduced</u>
- 21 speed.

- 23 Section 3. Sections 3307(c) and 3309 of Title 75 are amended
- 24 to read:
- 25 § 3307. No-passing zones.
- 26 \* \* \*
- 27 (c) Application of section. -- This section does not apply
- 28 [under]:
- 29 <u>(1) Under</u> the conditions described in section 3301(a)(2)
- and (5) (relating to driving on right side of roadway).

- 1 (2) To overtaking pedalcycles in accordance with
- 2 sections 3303(a)(3) (relating to overtaking vehicle on the
- 3 left) and 3305 (relating to limitations on overtaking on the
- 4 <u>left).</u>
- 5 § 3309. Driving on roadways laned for traffic.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- Whenever any roadway has been divided
- 7 into two or more clearly marked lanes for traffic the following
- 8 rules in addition to all others not inconsistent therewith shall
- 9 apply:
- 10 (1) Driving within single lane. -- A vehicle shall be
- driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane
- and shall not be moved from the lane until the driver has
- first ascertained that the movement can be made with safety.
- 14 (2) Three lane roadways.--Upon a roadway which is
- divided into three lanes and provides for two-way movement of
- traffic, a vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane
- 17 except when overtaking and passing another vehicle traveling
- 18 in the same direction when the center lane is clear of
- traffic within a safe distance, or in preparation for making
- 20 a left turn, or where the center lane is allocated
- 21 exclusively to traffic moving in the same direction that the
- 22 vehicle is proceeding and the allocation is designated by
- 23 official traffic-control devices.
- 24 (3) Lanes limited to specific use. -- Official traffic-
- control devices may be erected to restrict the use of
- 26 specified lanes to specified classes or types of traffic or
- vehicles, including multioccupant vehicles or car pools, and
- drivers of vehicles shall obey the directions of every such
- device.
- 30 (4) Prohibitions against changing lanes. -- Official

- 1 traffic-control devices may be installed prohibiting the
- 2 changing of lanes on a section of roadway and drivers of
- 3 vehicles shall obey the directions of every such device.
- 4 (b) Application of section. -- This section does not apply to
- 5 overtaking pedalcycles in accordance with sections 3303(a)(3)
- 6 (relating to overtaking vehicle on the left) and 3305 (relating
- 7 to limitations on overtaking on the left).
- 8 Section 4. Section 3331 of Title 75 is amended by adding a
- 9 subsection to read:
- 10 § 3331. Required position and method of turning.
- 11 \* \* \*
- 12 (e) Interference with pedalcycles. -- No turn by a driver of a
- 13 motor vehicle shall interfere with a pedalcycle proceeding
- 14 <u>straight while operating in accordance with Chapter 35 (relating</u>
- 15 to special vehicles and pedestrians).
- Section 5. Section 3364(b) of Title 75 is amended and the
- 17 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 18 § 3364. Minimum speed regulation.
- 19 \* \* \*
- 20 (b) Slow moving vehicle to drive off roadway. -- Except when
- 21 reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance
- 22 with law, whenever any person drives a motor vehicle upon a
- 23 roadway having width for not more than one lane of traffic in
- 24 each direction at less than the maximum posted speed and at such
- 25 a slow speed as to impede the normal and reasonable movement of
- 26 traffic, the driver shall, at the first opportunity when and
- 27 where it is reasonable and safe to do so and after giving
- 28 appropriate signal, drive completely off the roadway and onto
- 29 the berm or shoulder of the highway. The driver may return to
- 30 the roadway after giving appropriate signal only when the

- 1 movement can be made in safety and so as not to impede the
- 2 normal and reasonable movement of traffic.

- 4 (d) Application of section. -- This section does not apply to
- 5 pedalcycles operating in accordance with Chapter 35 (relating to
- 6 <u>special vehicles and pedestrians</u>).
- 7 Section 6. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
