AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining the offense of harassment of
- 3 soldier or veteran.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
- 7 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2703.2. Aggravated harassment of soldier or veteran.
- 9 A person commits a felony of the third degree if he, knowing
- 10 or believing a person to be a soldier or veteran, intentionally
- 11 or knowingly causes or attempts to cause the person to come into
- 12 contact with blood, seminal fluid, saliva, urine or feces by
- 13 throwing, tossing, spitting or expelling such fluid or material.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
