## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for Sunday trading.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 7365 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 7365. [Trading in motor vehicles and trailers.] <u>Sunday</u>
- 8 trading.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of a summary
- 10 offense if he engages in the business of buying, selling,
- 11 exchanging, trading, or otherwise dealing in new or used motor
- 12 vehicles or trailers, on Sunday. This section does not apply to
- 13 the buying, selling, exchanging, trading or otherwise dealing in
- 14 new or used motorcycles as defined in subsection (c).
- 15 (b) Repeated offense penalty. -- A person who commits a second
- 16 or any subsequent offense within one year after conviction for
- 17 the first offense, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not

- 1 exceeding \$200.
- 2 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section the following
- 3 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 4 subsection:
- 5 "Motor vehicle." Every self-propelled device in, upon or by
- 6 which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn
- 7 on a public highway.
- 8 "Motorcycle." A motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for
- 9 the use of the rider and is designed to travel on not more than
- 10 three wheels in contact with the ground.
- "Trailer." Every vehicle, without motor power, designed to
- 12 carry property or passengers or designed and used exclusively
- 13 for living quarters wholly on its own structure, and to be drawn
- 14 by a motor vehicle.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
