## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing 5 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," further providing, in hotel occupancy tax, for 10 definitions. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The definition of "rent" in section 209(a) of the 14 act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code 15 of 1971, amended May 2, 1974 (P.L.269, No.75), is amended and 16 17 the section is amended by adding a definition to read: 18 Section 209. Definitions. -- (a) For the purposes of this 19 part V only, the following words, terms and phrases shall have 20 the meaning ascribed to them in this subsection, except where

the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

- 2 (6) "Rent." The consideration received for occupancy valued
- 3 in money, whether received in money or otherwise, including all
- 4 receipts, cash, credits and property or services of any kind or
- 5 nature, any amount charged by an intermediary to an occupant and
- 6 <u>retained by the intermediary</u> and also any amount for which the
- 7 occupant is liable for the occupancy without any deduction
- 8 therefrom whatsoever. The term "rent" shall not include a
- 9 gratuity.
- 10 (7) "Intermediary." A person who is not an operator that
- 11 <u>facilitates the booking of hotel reservations.</u>

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
