AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Philadelphia Health and Education
- 2 Corporation for the Colleges of Medicine, Public Health,
- 3 Nursing and Health Professions for continuation of pediatric
- 4 services.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The sum of \$633,000 is hereby appropriated to the
- 8 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation, for the fiscal
- 9 year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, for continued pediatric
- 10 outpatient and inpatient treatment of severe physically
- 11 disabling diseases.
- 12 Section 2. Payments to the Philadelphia Health and Education
- 13 Corporation on account of the appropriation provided in section
- 14 1 shall be made in equal quarterly payments by the Secretary of
- 15 Health.
- 16 Section 3. The Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation
- 17 shall provide full, complete and accurate information for the
- 18 appropriation under section 1 as may be required by the
- 19 Department of Health or the chairman or the minority chairman of

- 1 the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or
- 2 the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 3 House of Representatives.
- 4 Section 4. The trustees of the Philadelphia Health and
- 5 Education Corporation for the Colleges of Medicine, Public
- 6 Health, Nursing and Health Professions shall report on forms
- 7 provided by the Department of Health to both the chairman and
- 8 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate
- 9 and the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 10 Committee of the House of Representatives by September 30, 2010,
- 11 on how State-appropriated funds were expended for fiscal year
- 12 2009-2010 to provide services to Pennsylvania residents.
- 13 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, or
- 14 immediately, whichever is later.
