## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for broadcast employee contracts; and providing for 2 enforcement.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and shall be cited as the Broadcast
- 7 Employment Free Market Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Broadcast employee." Any employee of a broadcast industry
- 13 employer, excluding sales and management employees.
- 14 "Broadcast industry employer." Television stations and
- 15 networks, radio stations and networks and cable stations and
- 16 networks and any associated broadcast entity.
- 17 Section 3. Prohibitions.

- 1 A broadcast industry employer shall not require, in any
- 2 employment contract, that a broadcast employee or prospective
- 3 broadcast employee refrain from obtaining employment in a
- 4 specified geographic area for a specific period of time after
- 5 termination of employment with that broadcast industry employer.
- 6 Section 4. Contract void and unenforceable.
- 7 A contract that contains a provision prohibited under section
- 8 3 shall be void and unenforceable with respect to such
- 9 provision.
- 10 Section 5. Violations.
- Any person who violates the provisions of this act shall be
- 12 liable for attorney fees and court costs.
- 13 Section 6. Applicability.
- 14 This act shall apply to contracts entered into on or after
- 15 the effective date of this act.
- 16 Section 7. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
