- 12 National Football League team to win six Super Bowls; and
- WHEREAS, On October 29, 2008, the Philadelphia Phillies won
- 14 the World Series after beating the Tampa Bay Rays in five games
- 15 to claim the franchise's second World Championship; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is proud of the excellence these

- 2 especially in these difficult economic times; therefore be it
