## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the
- offense of ethnic intimidation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2710 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2710. Ethnic intimidation.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of ethnic
- 10 intimidation if[, with]:
- 11 (1) with malicious intention toward the actual or
- 12 perceived race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry,
- 13 mental or physical disability, sexual orientation, gender or
- 14 gender identity of another individual or group of
- 15 individuals, he commits an offense under any other provision
- of this article or under Chapter 33 (relating to arson,
- 17 criminal mischief and other property destruction) exclusive
- of section 3307 (relating to institutional vandalism) or

- 1 under section 3503 (relating to criminal trespass) with
- 2 respect to such individual or his or her property or with
- 3 respect to one or more members of such group or to their
- 4 property[.]; or
- 5 (2) he intentionally or recklessly displays a symbol
- 6 which is offensive to the race, color, religion, national
- 7 <u>origin, ancestry, mental or physical disability, sexual</u>
- 8 <u>orientation, gender or gender identity of another individual</u>
- 9 or group of individuals or used the symbol in a manner to
- intimidate or endanger the individual or group of individuals
- 11 <u>through its display.</u>
- 12 (b) Grading.--
- 13 <u>(1)</u> An offense under [this section] <u>subsection (a)</u>
- 14 (1) shall be classified as a misdemeanor of the third degree
- if the other offense is classified as a summary offense.
- Otherwise, an offense under this section shall be classified
- 17 one degree higher in the classification specified in section
- 18 106 (relating to classes of offenses) than the classification
- of the other offense.
- 20 (2) An offense under subsection (a) (2) shall be
- 21 <u>classified as a misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 22 (c) Definition.--[As used in this section "malicious
- 23 intention" means the As used in this section, the following
- 24 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 25 subsection:
- 26 "Malicious intention." The intention to commit any act, the
- 27 commission of which is a necessary element of any offense
- 28 referred to in subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the
- 29 actual or perceived race, color, religion or national origin,
- 30 ancestry, mental or physical disability, sexual orientation,

- 1 gender or gender identity of another individual or group of
- 2 individuals.
- 3 "Symbol." The term includes, but is not limited to, a noose,
- 4 <u>swastika or simulation thereof.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
