## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the Governor's Schools of Excellence for programs offered in 2009.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Definitions.
- 6 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 7 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 8 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 "Governor's School of Excellence." Includes:
- 10 (1) School for the Agriculture Sciences at The
- 11 Pennsylvania State University.
- 12 (2) School for International Studies at the University
- of Pittsburgh.
- 14 (3) School for Health Care at University of Pittsburgh.
- 15 (4) School for Teaching at Millersville University.

- 1 Section 2. Governor's Schools of Excellence.
- 2 (a) Universities receiving State funding. -- Pennsylvania
- 3 universities that received State funds in fiscal year 2008-2009
- 4 for the purpose of sponsoring a Governor's School of Excellence
- 5 in 2008 shall sponsor a Governor's School of Excellence in 2009
- 6 as a condition of receiving any State appropriation for fiscal
- 7 year 2009-2010.
- 8 (b) Payment not required. -- Students attending a Governor's
- 9 School of Excellence shall not be required to pay any tuition or
- 10 fees to attend and participate in a Governor's School of
- 11 Excellence program in 2009.
- 12 Section 3. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect immediately.
