## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," providing for blood donation
- 6 education.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1526. Blood Donation Education. -- (a) The department
- 13 shall, in cooperation with the Department of Health:
- 14 (1) Establish a unit of instruction to educate students in
- 15 grades eleven and twelve regarding blood donation, to emphasize
- 16 the need for donated blood and to encourage blood donation and
- 17 participation in blood donation programs for students in grades
- 18 <u>eleven and twelve.</u>
- 19 (2) Develop and distribute appropriate educational materials
- 20 and resources to educators and public and nonpublic schools.

- 1 (b) The unit of instruction required under subsection (a)
- 2 <u>shall be integrated within the health course of study required</u>
- 3 in accordance with the State Board of Education regulations
- 4 <u>contained in 22 Pa. Code Ch. 4 (relating to academic standards</u>
- 5 <u>and assessment). The department may utilize any appropriate</u>
- 6 <u>public or private materials</u>, <u>personnel and other resources in</u>
- 7 <u>developing and implementing this unit of instruction.</u>
- 8 (c) The unit of instruction required under subsection (a)
- 9 <u>shall include:</u>
- 10 (1) A physiology component relating to blood, blood types
- 11 and the circulatory system.
- 12 (2) A need and usage component that includes information
- 13 relating to:
- 14 (i) The frequency of and situations where donated blood is
- 15 needed.
- 16 (ii) Procedures utilized for the collection of donated blood
- 17 and the safety of those procedures.
- 18 (iii) Procedures utilized for the storage of donated blood
- 19 and the various uses of donated blood.
- 20 (iv) Specific instances where an available donated blood
- 21 supply assisted individuals in need.
- 22 (3) A participation component to encourage students to
- 23 donate blood and volunteer at local blood banks, which component
- 24 emphasizes the personal rewards and community benefits from
- 25 donation and participation.
- 26 (d) (1) A student shall be excused from participation in
- 27 the unit of instruction required under subsection (a) if the
- 28 student or, if the student is less than eighteen (18) years of
- 29 age, the student's parent or quardian objects in writing to such
- 30 participation on religious grounds.

- 1 (2) No student excused under paragraph (1) shall be
- 2 penalized for such excuse. During the time period that the unit\_
- 3 of instruction is presented, a substitute unit of instruction
- 4 shall be provided to the student in accordance with regulations
- 5 promulgated by the State Board of Education.
- 6 (e) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and
- 7 regulations necessary for the implementation of this section.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
