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## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 3 government; providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts 4 due the Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and 5 other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 7 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 8 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 9 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 10 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 13 14 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 15 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 16 17 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of 18 19 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 20 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 21 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 22 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 23 24 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 25 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 26 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 27 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 28 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 29 Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, further 30 providing for the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency. 31

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 1 hereby enacts as follows:
- 2 Section 1. Section 1735-E of the act of April 9, 1929
- 3 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, added July 17, 2007
- 4 (P.L.141, No.42), is amended to read:
- 5 Section 1735-E. Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency
- [ (Reserved) ].
- 7 The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency shall provide
- 8 <u>semiannual reports of all grants awarded by the Pennsylvania</u>
- 9 <u>Emergency Management Agency from Federal disaster assistance or</u>
- 10 relief funds, homeland security and defense funds, avian
- 11 <u>flu/pandemic preparedness or other public health emergency funds</u>
- 12 to the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 13 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman
- 14 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 15 The reports shall include information relating to the entity
- 16 receiving grant money from the agency, including the name and
- 17 address of the entity, the amount of the grant, the date of
- 18 <u>issuance</u> and the purpose of the grant. Reports shall be
- 19 <u>submitted by August 15 for grants awarded during the period from</u>
- 20 <u>January 1 through June 30 and by February 15 for grants awarded</u>
- 21 during the period from July 1 through December 31.
- 22 Section 2. The amendment of section 1735-E of the act shall
- 23 apply retroactively to July 1, 2009.
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
