16	valid will executed by the decedent and section 8611(a)
17	(relating to persons who may execute anatomical gift).

1 (e) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 3 subsection:

5 <u>"DD Form 93." A valid document or a successor form provided</u> 6 <u>by the Department of Defense that is signed by a member of the</u> 7 <u>armed services and designates a person to direct the disposition</u> 8 <u>of the remains of the person who signed the form.</u> 9 * * *
