AN ACT

Amending the act of July 6, 2010 (P.L. , No.1A), entitled "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011, for certain 5 institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 2010; to provide appropriations from the State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance 9 Fund, the Aviation Restricted Revenue Account, the Hazardous 10 Material Response Fund, The State Stores Fund, the Milk 11 Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust Fund, the Emergency 12 Medical Services Operating Fund, the Tuition Payment Fund, 13 the Banking Department Fund, the Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology Development Authority Fund and 14 15 the Tobacco Settlement Fund to the Executive Department; to 16 17 provide appropriations from the Judicial Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial Department for the 18 fiscal year July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011; to provide 19 appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal 20 21 year July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011, for the proper operation of the several departments of the Commonwealth and the 22 Pennsylvania State Police authorized to spend Motor License 23 Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal 24 funds to the Executive Department of the Commonwealth and for 25 the payment of bills remaining unpaid at the close of the 26 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010; and to provide for the 27 additional appropriation of Federal and State funds from the 28 29 General Fund and the State Lottery Fund for the Executive 30 Department of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 31 2009, to June 30, 2010, and for the payment of bills incurred

1 2 3 4	and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009," by further providing for the appropriation of Federal funds and reducing the State appropriation to the Department of Education for basic education.
