## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 1 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in budget and finance, further providing for Commonwealth portion of fines. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3571(b)(2) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the subsection 7 is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 § 3571. Commonwealth portion of fines, etc. \* \* \* 10 11 (b) Vehicle offenses. --12 13 Except as provided in [paragraph (4)] paragraphs (4) 14 and (5), when prosecution under any other provision of Title 15 75 (relating to vehicles) is the result of State Police 16 action, all of the following apply: (i) All fines, forfeited recognizances and other 17 18 forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited shall be payable

1 to the Commonwealth, for credit to the Motor License 2 Fund. One-half of the revenue shall be paid to 3 municipalities as designated in subparagraph (ii) in the same ratio provided in section 4 of the act of June 1, 4 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), [relating to partial 5 6 allocation of liquid fuels and fuel use tax proceeds.] 7 referred to as the Liquid Fuels Tax Municipal Allocation 8 Law. (ii) Distribution of revenue is as follows: 9 10 (A) Only a municipality that has a population of not more than 3,000 or that provides at least 40 11 12 hours per week of local police services through a 13 municipal police department, participation in a 14 regional police department or contracts with other municipal or regional police for police services may 15 16 receive revenue under subparagraph (i). (B) Revenue that is not paid to municipalities 17 18 under clause (A) shall be DEPOSITED INTO A RESTRICTED ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND AND transferred to 19 the Pennsylvania State Police for cadet classes. 20 21 (C) ALL REVENUE WITHIN THE RESTRICTED ACCOUNT 22 UNDER CLAUSE (B) SHALL BE USED SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE 23 OF TRAINING NEW PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE TROOPERS. 9	(G) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE
10	POLICE, THE ANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED UNDER CLAUSE (D)
11	MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL

14	(5) When prosecution under any other provision of Title
15	75 is the result of State Police action on an interstate
16	highway, as defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to
17	definitions), all fines, forfeited recognizances and other
18	forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited shall be payable to
19	the Commonwealth, for credit to the Motor License Fund.
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21	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
