AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556, No.101), entitled "An act providing for planning for the processing and disposal of municipal waste; requiring counties to submit 3 plans for municipal waste management systems within their 4 boundaries; authorizing grants to counties and municipalities 5 for planning, resource recovery and recycling; imposing and 6 collecting fees; establishing certain rights for host 7 municipalities; requiring municipalities to implement 8 recycling programs; requiring Commonwealth agencies to 9 procure recycled materials; imposing duties; granting powers 10 to counties and municipalities; authorizing the Environmental 11 Quality Board to adopt regulations; authorizing the 12 13 Department of Environmental Resources to implement this act; providing remedies; prescribing penalties; establishing a 14 fund; and making repeals," in general provisions, defining 15 "yard waste," and in grants, further providing for general 16 limitations. 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 20 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556,
- 21 No. 101), known as the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and
- 22 Waste Reduction Act, is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 23 Section 103. Definitions.
- 24 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 25 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 3 "Yard waste." The term includes, but is not limited to, leaf
- 4 waste.
- 5 Section 2. Section 905(c) of the act, amended December 9,
- 6 2002 (P.L.1404, No.175), is amended to read:
- 7 Section 905. General limitations.

- 9 (c) Other limitations on grants. -- The department may not
- 10 award any grant under this chapter to any county or municipality
- 11 that has failed to comply with the conditions set forth in
- 12 previously awarded grants under this chapter, the requirements
- 13 of this chapter and any regulations promulgated pursuant
- 14 thereto, provided that the department shall not prohibit the
- 15 award of any grant to a county or municipality that has adopted
- 16 an ordinance allowing the limited burning of yard waste, leaf
- 17 waste, or both.

- 19 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
