1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for Pennsylvania Gaming Control
3 Board established.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:


6 Section 1. Section ~~1201(h)(2)~~ 1201(H) of Title 4 of the 
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes ~~is amended and the subsection~~ 
8 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

9 § 1201. Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board established.

13 ~~(2) Except for ex officio members, no person shall be~~ 
14 ~~appointed a member of the board or be employed by or be an~~
15 ~~independent contractor of the board if that person is a~~
16 ~~public official or party officer as defined in section 1512-~~

1 ~~(relating to financial and employment interests) in this~~
2 ~~Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions. The~~
3 ~~following public officials may not be appointed a member of~~
4 ~~the board during the two year period following the~~
5 ~~termination of the official's term of office:~~

6 ~~(i) The Governor.~~

7 ~~(ii) The Attorney General.~~

10 ~~(2.1) No officer, director or key employee of a gaming~~ ←
11 ~~LICENSED entity licensed under this part at any time during~~ ←
12 ~~the previous four years shall be appointed a member of the~~
13 ~~board FOR TWO YEARS FOLLOWING TERMINATION OF THE TERM OF~~ ←
14 ~~OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE LICENSED ENTITY.~~
