13	(2) Except for ex officio members, no person shall be
14	appointed a member of the board or be employed by or be an-
15	independent contractor of the board if that person is a
16	public official or party officer as defined in section 1512

1	(relating to financial and employment interests) in this-
2	Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions. The
3	following public officials may not be appointed a member of
4	the board during the two year period following the
5	termination of the official's term of office:
6	(i) The Governor.
7	(ii) The Attorney General.
8	(iii) The Auditor General.
9	(iv) A member of the General Assembly.
10	(2.1) No officer, director or key employee of a gaming
11	LICENSED entity licensed under this part at any time during
12	the previous four years shall be appointed a member of the
13	board FOR TWO YEARS FOLLOWING TERMINATION OF THE TERM OF
14	OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE LICENSED ENTITY.

16	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
