## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," providing for contracts to promote
- 6 participation.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 2003-A.2. Contracts to Promote Participation. -- (a)
- 13 The system shall develop, adopt and implement binding policies
- 14 or quidelines to ensure that all persons are accorded equal
- 15 opportunity in contracting and subcontracting associated with
- 16 construction, repair, renovation and maintenance projects,
- 17 including all aspects of project management, design and
- 18 construction and legal and administrative services necessary to
- 19 the completion of a project.
- 20 (b) Every contract for or on behalf of the system for a

- 1 construction, repair, renovation and maintenance project shall
- 2 contain provisions by which the contractor agrees to promote,
- 3 <u>increase and sustain contracting and subcontracting</u>
- 4 opportunities for disadvantaged businesses.
- 5 (c) This section shall apply to:
- 6 (1) Any contract which is subject to competitive bidding.
- 7 (2) All system contractors, subcontractors, assignees,
- 8 <u>lessees</u>, <u>agents</u>, <u>vendors</u> and <u>suppliers</u>.
- 9 <u>(3) Any disadvantaged business.</u>
- 10 (d) The system may use the lists of certified minority-
- 11 owned, women-owned and veteran-owned business enterprises which
- 12 have been certified under the Department of General Services'
- 13 <u>disadvantaged business program to compete for and participate in</u>
- 14 the system's contracting process. The Department of General
- 15 Services shall cooperate with and assist the system in carrying
- 16 <u>out the requirements of this subsection.</u>
- 17 (e) For the purpose of this section, the following words and
- 18 phrases shall have the meaning given to them in this subsection
- 19 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Disadvantaged business." A small business which is owned or
- 21 controlled by a majority of persons, not limited to members of
- 22 minority groups, who:
- 23 (1) have been deprived of the opportunity to develop and
- 24 maintain a competitive position in the economy because of social
- 25 <u>disadvantages; or</u>
- 26 (2) are veterans, including service-disabled veterans.
- 27 <u>"Service-disabled veteran." A veteran who possesses either</u>
- 28 an adjudication letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- 29 <u>establishing a service-connected disability rating or a</u>
- 30 disability determination from the Department of Defense.

- 1 <u>"Small business."</u> The term shall have the meaning given to
- 2 it in 62 Pa.C.S. § 2102 (relating to definitions).
- 3 "Veteran." An individual who:
- 4 (1) served in the active United States military in any of
- 5 the four current branches and all previous branches, including a
- 6 reserve component or the National Guard;
- 7 (2) was released or discharged from active military service
- 8 under conditions other than dishonorable; and
- 9 (3) possesses a certificate of release or discharge from
- 10 active duty.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
