AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," further providing for definitions;  
6 and providing for notice of peanut or tree nut allergies.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1401 of the act of March 10, 1949  
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is  
11 amended by adding a clause to read:

12 Section 1401. Definitions.--As used in this article--

13 \* \* \*

14 (13) "School building" means a facility used by the school  
15 district for the purpose of teaching elementary or middle school  
16 students.

17 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

18 Section 1422.4. Notice of Peanut or Tree Nut Allergies.--(a)  
19 A school that enrolls an elementary or middle school student who  
20 has a peanut or tree nut allergy shall post a notice that a

1 student within the school building has a peanut or tree nut  
2 allergy. The notice may not identify the student with the  
3 allergy. The notice shall be placed in plain view within the  
4 school building at every point of entry and in the cafeteria.

5 (b) The school that enrolls the student under subsection (a)  
6 shall prohibit the sale of any product containing a peanut or  
7 tree nut in the cafeteria.

8 (c) The school that enrolls the student under subsection (a)  
9 shall notify the school district or joint school board. Within a  
10 reasonable time after receiving the notice, the school district  
11 or joint school board shall designate all of the following:

12 (1) a cafeteria table to be peanut or tree nut free; and

13 (2) one classroom per grade level to be peanut or tree nut  
14 free.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
