13	(b) Dissemination to noncriminal justice agencies and
14	individualsCriminal history record information shall be
15	disseminated by a State or local police department to any
16	individual or noncriminal justice agency only upon request.
17	Except as provided in subsection (b.1):
18	(1) A fee may be charged by a State or local police
19	department for each request for criminal history record
20	information by an individual or noncriminal justice agency,

except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who makes the request in order to apply to become a volunteer with an affiliate of <u>United States Youth Soccer</u>, Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of America or with a rape crisis center or domestic violence program.

6 (2) Before a State or local police department 7 disseminates criminal history record information to an 8 individual or noncriminal justice agency, it shall extract 9 from the record all notations of arrests, indictments or 10 other information relating to the initiation of criminal 11 proceedings where:

12 (i) three years have elapsed from the date of13 arrest;

14 (ii) no conviction has occurred; and 15 (iii) no proceedings are pending seeking a 16 conviction.

(h) Fees.--The department may charge a fee not to exceed \$10 in order to conduct the certification as required in subsection (b)(2), except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who makes the request in order to apply to become a volunteer with an affiliate of <u>United States Youth Soccer</u>, Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of America or with a rape crisis center or domestic violence shelter.
