A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for criteria for institutions of purely public charity.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That Article III be amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 18.1. Criteria for institutions of purely public charity.
10	If the General Assembly exercises its authority under section
11	2(a)(v) of Article VIII of this Constitution by legislation, no
12	criteria other than those specified in the legislation may be
13	used to determine the qualifications of an institution of purely
14	public charity.
15	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
16	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
17	Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
18	comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article

1 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 2 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 3 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 4 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

5 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 6 7 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 8 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 9 10 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 11 12 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 13 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 14 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 15 primary, general or municipal election which meets the requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 16 17 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 18 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 19 passed by the General Assembly.
