14 (a.1) General rule.--An annual permit may be issued 15 authorizing movement on specified highways of:

17 (3) aircraft refueling vehicles or vehicles and 18 combinations carrying raw milk, raw coal, flat-rolled steel 19 coils, steel slabs, hot ingots, a hot box, pulpwood and wood 20 chips [or], raw water or cryogenic liquid which exceed the 21 maximum weight specified in Subchapter C while they are in 22 the course of manufacture and under contract with or under 23 the direct control of the manufacturer, provided that they do 24 not exceed the maximum height, width or length specified in 25 Subchapter B unless they also qualify under paragraph (1), 26 subject to the provisions in subsection (a.2).

29 (13) A combination of vehicles that hauls cryogenic

9	(A) AUTHORIZATIONEXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (B),
10	ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
11	(1) AN ANNUAL PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED AUTHORIZING THE
12	MOVEMENT ON HIGHWAYS TO HAUL EGGS TO OR FROM A PROCESSOR BY
