Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, IN SEXUAL OFFENSES, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR <--DEFINITIONS; IN MINORS, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; and, IN SENTENCING, providing for <-sentencing for offenses involving child pornography SEXUAL <--ABUSE OF CHILDREN. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1.
