16	<u>under eighteen years of age.</u>

18	"Direct contact with children" means the possibility of care,
19	supervision, guidance or control of children or routine
20	interaction with children.

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2	Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
3	Section 1022. Child Abuse Recognition and Reporting
4	TrainingWithin one hundred eighty days of the effective date
5	of this section, the department shall adopt regulations to
6	require that operators of child day care centers and employes
7	who have direct contact with children receive child abuse
8	recognition and reporting training. The following shall apply:
9	(1) Operators shall receive three hours of training prior to
10	the issuance of a license and three hours of training every five
11	years thereafter.
12	(2) Employes who have direct contact with children shall
13	receive three hours of training within ninety days of the date
14	of hire and three hours of training every five years thereafter.
15	(3) Training programs shall be approved by the department,
16	and shall address, but not be limited to:
17	(i) Recognition of the signs of abuse and reporting
18	requirements for suspected abuse in this Commonwealth.
19	(ii) The child day care center's policies related to

4	Section 1076.1. Child Abuse Recognition and Reporting
5	TrainingWithin one hundred eighty days of the effective date
6	of this section, the department shall adopt regulations to
7	require that operators of family day care homes and employes who
8	have direct contact with children receive child abuse
9	recognition and reporting training. The following shall apply:
10	(1) Operators shall receive three hours of training prior to
11	the issuance of a registration certificate and three hours of
12	training every five years thereafter.
13	(2) Employes who have direct contact with children shall
14	receive three hours of training within ninety days of the date
15	of hire and three hours of training every five years thereafter.
16	(3) Training programs shall be approved by the department,
17	and shall address, but not be limited to, the recognition of the
18	signs of abuse and reporting requirements for suspected abuse in
19	this Commonwealth.
20	Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
