## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of trafficking of persons.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3002 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3002. Trafficking of persons.
9	(a) Offense definedA person commits an offense if the
10	person [knowingly] <u>:</u>
11	(1) knowingly traffics or knowingly attempts to traffic
12	another person, knowing that the other person will be
13	subjected to forced labor or services[.] <u>; or</u>
14	(2) for the purpose of financial gain, intentionally
15	traffics another person with knowledge or reason to know that
16	the other person:

1	(i) is not a citizen of the United States; and
2	(ii) cannot produce Federal documentation pertaining
3	to presence in the United States.
4	(b) Grading[An]
5	(1) Except as set forth in paragraph (2):
6	<u>(i) An</u> offense under subsection [(a)] <u>(a)(1)</u> shall
7	be graded a felony of the second degree [unless].
8	(ii) An offense under subsection (a)(2) shall be
9	graded a felony of the third degree.
10	(2) If the other person suffers bodily injury or the
11	other person is an individual under 18 years of age, [in
12	which case it] an offense under subsection (a) shall be
13	graded as a felony of the first degree.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
